A second wave of cold stun sea turtles leave CMA team in need

Clearwater, FL (February 10, 2016) – As cold weather continues, Clearwater Marine Aquarium (CMA) turtle department and stranding team have been working day and night to rescue and rehab an ever-growing population of sea turtle patients.

Last month, the turtle team at CMA reported nearly 30 cold stun intakes over a single weekend, and hospital activity hasn't shown any sign of slowing down in February. The 2016 total intake count is over 140, with 69 live sea turtles arriving at CMA, including 12 arrivals yesterday and 11 arrivals today.

Most of the cold stun turtles are also battling the fibropapilloma virus, requiring critical care and treatments from the team. With more turtles arriving hourly, the team is stretched thin, needing all the help they can get.

Duke Energy is a proud sponsor of the sea turtle program, but with the incredible number of intakes, the CMA team has an urgent need for additional supplies to help the new patients survive.
