New Free Music & Arts Festival Announced

Music, arts, helicopter 45,000 Easter egg drop and fireworks in Safety Harbor

Palm Harbor, FL (March 24, 2017) – Along with its partners Harborside Christian Church, Dick Norris Buick GMC, Clearwater Marine Aquarium and the City of Safety Harbor, Project Primavera announces the inaugural *Primavera Music and Arts Festival*. The festival, to benefit Project Primavera's work with at-risk youth, brings a fun-filled day of music, art, food and family activities culminating in a free fireworks celebration to downtown Safety Harbor on Saturday, April 8th.
