  - Skylar Ann. Named in honor of Skylar Ann Scarnecchia, eleven-year-old cancer survivor and amputee, who impresses us with her courage and smile. Her prosthetic leg comes from Hanger Clinic, where Winter gets her prosthetic tail
  - **Tyndall.** Named in honor of Caleb Tyndall, an amazing 23-year-old with extensive medical issues, and inspired by Winter's refusal to give up.
  - **Matthew.** Named in honor of Army Staff Sgt. Mathew Steven Sitton, who died in August 2012, after stepping on an improvised explosive device in Afghanistan. Matthew lived in Pinellas County.
